French Presidential Election 2027. Document structuring ideas. Formatting only, not validation or analysis of content.

I. Liberty

1. Economic liberty and liberal measures (ESG)

Economic liberty and liberal measures, within sustainable constraints (Environmental, Social, Governance).

2. Individual limits on resource consumption

Implementation of individual limits on resource consumption (water, energy, etc.).

3. Ethical limits on technology and life

Definition of ethical limits on: procreation, assisted suicide, augmented humans, life extension, AI in defense, space conquest.

4. Priority for French and European production

Priority for French and European production; use of tariffs on strategic sectors when necessary.

II. Environment

1. Ecological policy based on ESG criteria

Ecological policy based on ESG criteria.

2. Massive reduction of energy consumption

Massive reduction of national energy consumption (systematic insulation, heat pumps, slower and lighter vehicles, sustainable construction projects, etc.).

3. Long-term territorial planning

Long-term territorial planning with preservation of heritage and traditions.

4. Penalties for insufficiently sustainable projects

Penalties for projects deemed too fast or insufficiently sustainable.

5. Respect for elders and transmission of traditions

Respect for elders and transmission of traditions.

6. Return to predominantly organic agriculture

Return to predominantly organic agriculture.

7. Environmental tariffs

Environmental tariffs for products not meeting French or European standards.

8. Transport reorganization

Transport reorganization: rail priority, car-sharing development, limitation of air transport.

III. Democracy, institutions and society

1. Sixth Republic and digital referendums

Institutional reform toward a Sixth Republic based on digital referendums.

2. Return to the seven-year presidential term

Return to the seven-year presidential term.

3. Blue-White-Red Card

Blue-White-Red Card guaranteeing fundamental needs: housing, health, food and hygiene.

4. Education reform

Education reform: new middle/high school formats, increased specialization, transformation of higher education.

5. New middle school format

Middle school in 4, 5 or 6 years depending on level (diploma required to vote). German model for free afternoons (languages, arts, sports).

6. A-level style baccalaureate

Baccalaureate modeled on the English A-levels format with 4 subjects, including at least one literary and one scientific.

7. Reduction of public spending and taxation

Reduction of public spending and taxation.

8. Strengthening of military budgets

Strengthening of military budgets for strategic autonomy.

9. Reform of the relationship with the European Union

Reform of the relationship with the EU and reflection on a simplified Europe (common standards and partnerships between countries).

10. Quebec project

Independence or France-Canada co-guardianship status to prevent the loss of Franco-Quebec language and culture.

11. Wealth cap

Cap on annual wealth and individual assets (EUR1M max/year and EUR100M max personal wealth).

12. Three levels of nationality

Creation of three levels of nationality (I: French only; II: Multinational French; III: French Friendship) and restriction of property access by status.

Rewards, merit and recognition

1. Reform of decoration systems

Reform of decoration and medal systems.

2. Order for Humanity

Creation of the Order for Humanity (single knight grade), France's most prestigious medal, awarded to those most involved in peace and prosperity.

3. Great Silver Dome in Lyon

Creation of a Great Silver Dome in Lyon gathering 120 internationally elected 'Eternals' to set humanity's ethical limits.

4. School excellence pathways

Excellence pathways in middle school, high school and university in scientific, sports, artistic and literary fields.

5. Access to distinctions from middle school

Access to distinctions from middle school.

6. Municipality name in surname

Possibility of adding one's municipality name to one's surname under conditions of service rendered.

7. Symbolic representative of Europe (Methuselah)

Proposal for a symbolic representative of Europe ('Methuselah').

Immigration and security

1. Migrant entry mechanisms

Creation of migrant entry mechanisms based on real economic needs.

2. Digital platform for sector needs

Digital platform for managing sector needs.

3. Removal of irregular migrants

Organization of removals of migrants in irregular situations.

4. European naval gendarmerie

Creation of a European naval gendarmerie for Mediterranean control.

Digital governance and sovereignty

1. French and European alternatives to major platforms

Development of French and European alternatives to major digital platforms.

2. Regaining control of strategic data

Regaining control of strategic and mapping data.

3. Public competitions for national digital sector

Public competitions and rewards to support national digital actors.

4. International Organization for Satellite Regulation (IOSR)

Creation of IOSR to limit the number of satellites in orbit and space debris, promote international cooperation.

Debt and public finances

1. Twenty-year debt reduction trajectory

Twenty-year debt reduction trajectory (reduction of civil servants, social benefits covered by the BBR card).

2. Zero public debt objective

Objective of zero public debt in the long term.

3. Zero re-borrowing enshrined in the Constitution

Future re-borrowing set as zero in the constitution, except in major crises.

4. Honor funds

Creation of 'honor funds', financed by citizens on subjects that matter to them (culture, specialized health, etc.).

Defense

1. Military dronization and AI

Development of dronization and AI in military systems while keeping humans at the center of decisions.

2. Maupertuis Marine Commando

Creation of the Maupertuis scientific excellence Marine Commando (scientists and reserve engineers).

3. Strengthening Foreign Legion and reserves

Strengthening of the Foreign Legion and reserves.

4. Arcanes association for reintegration

Creation of the Arcanes association for prisoner reintegration (AI-optimized pathways).

Economy and regulated professions

1. Reduction of rent-seeking situations

Reduction of rent-seeking situations.

2. Opening regulated professions to competition

Increased opening to competition in certain regulated professions.

3. Regulated AI in legal, medical and administrative professions

Development of regulated AI in legal, medical and administrative professions.

Transport and planning

1. Three major international airports only

Retention of only three major international airports (CDG, Orly and Nice).

2. Increased taxation of air transport

Increased taxation of air transport.

3. Reduction of high-emission air tourism

Reduction of highly emitting air tourism.

4. Massive rail development

Massive development of rail transport.

5. Shared and automated vehicles

Deployment of shared and automated vehicles.

Scientific excellence

1. Strengthening École Polytechnique

Strengthening École Polytechnique's role as an international scientific hub.

2. University competitiveness clusters

Strengthen France's university competitiveness clusters and European collaboration on strategic topics.

3. Transition to selective universities

Transition from elite 'Grandes écoles' to selective but globally open universities.

National cohesion

1. Monthly Obelix Feasts

Creation of monthly 'Obelix Feasts' in municipalities, state-funded, to foster cohesion and fraternity.

Civil service and competitive exams

1. Mathematics exam in major competitive exams

Introduction of a mathematics exam in major administrative competitive exams.

2. Experimental sciences exam in major competitive exams

Introduction of an experimental sciences exam in major administrative competitive exams to better address the climate transition.

Constitutional monarchy (institutional proposal)

1. Return of an elected lifelong king

Return of a king elected for life by the people from three candidates pre-selected by the Senate, representative role with certain constitutional veto rights.
